

List of Projects, Locations, and a Brief Explanation

- 1) Clearing Debris from along the sides of the trail.
 - a) **Area "A"** is the section of Trail along the north Side of Bair Creek beginning at the east crossing and running west to the second crossing, including the creek. (See Map)
 - b) **Area "B"** is the section of Trail along the north side of Bair Creek running west from the second creek crossing to the fourth creek crossing. (See Map)
 - c) **Area "C"** is the section of Trail beginning at the large pipe culvert and running west to the west end of the trail, including debris in the creek. (See Map)
- 2) Spreading Wood Mulch along the entire trail system. Individuals interested in this project must contact **Nathan Rich (801.614.5601)** with Wasatch Integrated Waste Management to arrange for the mulch and **Brandon Green (801.546.0861 ext#4)** with Fruit Heights City to arrange to have the mulch delivered. (A section of the trail will be marked out prior to your service project date.)
- 3) Construct and make improvements to small campsites at the east end of the park. (**Area "D"** on the Trails Map)
- 4) Plant bushes and other vegetation along the trail in City specified locations.
- 5) Complete the cutting of two (2) large logs into benches at **Areas "E" & "F"** along the trail.
- 6) Fundraising to purchase and plant **City Specified Trees** where several trees have died, been removed, or cut down during the trail clearing phase of this project.
- 7) Fundraising to purchase and construct park benches in specified areas along the trail.

List of Tools to consider

This may not be a complete list of tools that you will need but here is a list of tools to consider as you make plans for the various projects.

- Chain Saw(s)
- Hand Saw and Pruning Shears
- An Ax
- A Pickax
- Shovels and Rakes
- Wheelbarrow(s)

- An ATV for hauling out Debris (Fruit Heights City will provide 2 small trailers that can be pulled behind ATV's)

Required Items

The following items must be completed before a project can be placed on the schedule

- Obtain approval for the date and time of your service project from Council Member Scot Poole. He can be reached by calling 801-560-1970 or by emailing him at spoole@fruitheightscity.com
- Complete the participation agreement and submit it to Fruit Heights City on or before the project date.
- A minimum of two adults must be on site working with youth groups.
- If ATV's are being used, they must be operated by a licensed adult 21 years of age or older.
- All power equipment is to be used by a responsible adult.

Statement of Volunteer Activity

FRUIT HEIGHTS CITY, herein after called “The City,” and the Participant or organization, whose name and address is:

herein after called “The Participant,” hereby enter into this Agreement which provides that:

The Participant has agreed to provide volunteer service to the City more particularly described as follows:

The Participant acknowledges the potentially hazardous nature of the activity and agrees to the following terms and conditions:

- 1. A City official shall conduct an initial safety briefing for the Participant as part of a general orientation and expectation over the area being constructed, cleared or maintained.**
- 2. All persons including Participant and those associated with Participant shall wear approved safety vests provided by the City, when working in R.O.W. or along heavy traffic areas.**
- 3. The Participant and its members understand completely that there is no provision or expectation, present or future, for the receipt of compensation from Fruit Heights City for their voluntary efforts.**
- 4. The Participant and its members agree to participate in an initial interview/ screening process to ensure volunteers are capable of performing the necessary work and understand the nature of the activity for which they are volunteering.**

5. **The Participant will be responsible to organize and supervise all activities.**
6. **No work of any nature will be performed on the pavement or shoulders of the traveled way.**
7. **In the event of an emergency, the City may contact:**

8. **No alcoholic beverage shall be allowed while volunteers are working at the locations designated in this Agreement.**
9. **Notwithstanding any other provision of this Agreement, if in the sole judgment of the City it is determined that the Participant is not meeting the terms and conditions of this Agreement, or summarily if based upon unsafe activity, the City may terminate this Agreement.**
10. **The group/volunteer contact shall be required to seek permission from the City before any site modifications occur. Such site modifications may include, but are not limited to, planting of new trees, litter control, weed abatement along trails, installing new features, painting landscape structures, placing other monuments or constructing improvements on City trails. For questions regarding the above, contact Fruit Heights City.**
11. **The City, in its sole discretion, reserves the right to cancel the work which is the subject of this Agreement any time and for any reason. In the event the program is terminated, Participant hereby waives any claims it may have against the City based on termination of the program.**
